

# **Psychoeducational Teaching Facilitator**

### What we do

Motus carry out psychoeducational workshops with primary and secondary schools, specifically targeting the transitions into early and late adolescence. Our secondary school transition programme is directed towards 10-14 year olds, and includes a student workshop, a parent webinar and additional teaching resources. ## **Job Description**

The role of the facilitator is to teach our programmes. This involves coordinating a class of up to 30 pupils to receive the Motus programme. Prior to facilitation, there is training with an expert in the Motus programme, and each facilitator needs to be signed off before working in classrooms. Facilitators are expected to demonstrate skills such as strong psychological knowledge, clear presentation, and behaviour management.
